<b>Adjudication Platform</b>	Competition Suite <a href="https://competitionsuite.com/">https://competitionsuite.com/</a>
<b>Written Adjudication Feedback</b>	Written Feedback (in the form of PDF or Typed) will be provided through the digital platform.
<b>Verbal Adjudication Feedback</b>	Verbal commentary will only be provided at the end of a performance for solo classes.  Commentary is not to conflict with performances.
<b>Large Group Feedback</b>	Group feedback will be provided to performers/ competitors approximately every 45 minutes.
<b>Back-Up Recording</b>	A back-up recording of the performance will be provided through Competition Suite.
<b>Returning Performers/ Competitors</b>	Returning Performers/Competitors can log into their existing account. <a href="https://competitionsuite.com/login/">https://competitionsuite.com/login/</a>  Your performing classes will be visible in April 2024.
<b>New Performers/ Competitors</b>	New Performers/Competitors to CPAF must create a <b>NEW FREE</b> account through the signup process. <a href="https://competitionsuite.com/signup/">https://competitionsuite.com/signup/</a>  Please use the email you have used with your CPAF account. Your performing classes will be visible in April 2024.
